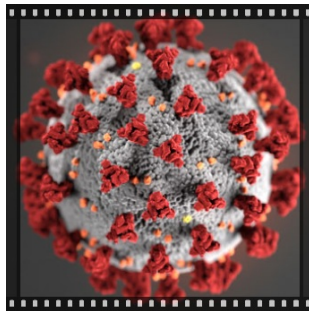

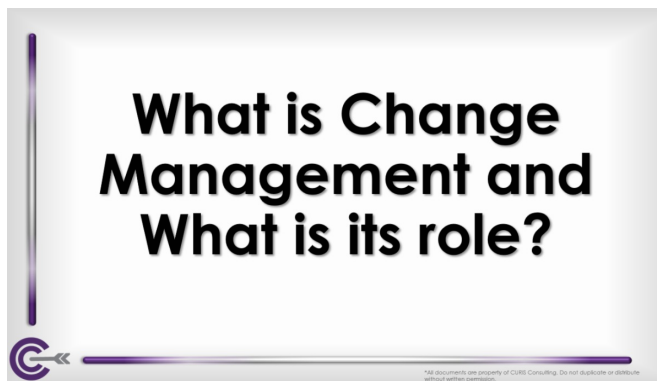
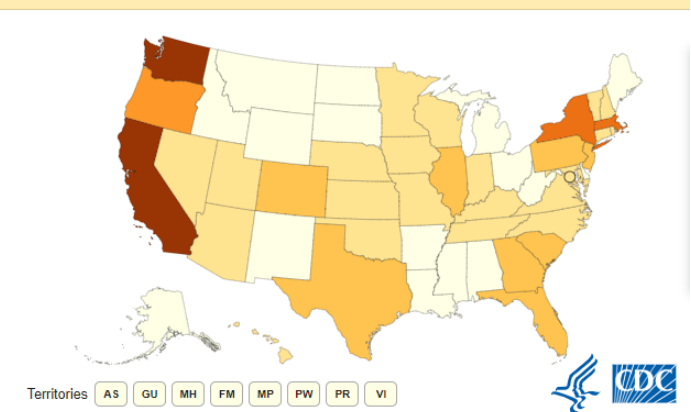

Answer:

Definition: It is the process, tools and techniques to manage the people side of **change** to achieve its required business outcomes. It is the systematic **management** of employee engagement and adoption when the organization **changes** how work will be done.

Role: Change management is both an art and a science. At its core are 3 basic, yet critical, elements:

1. **Engaged Leadership:** Engagement from organizational leadership who both understands and supports the proposed change
2. **Stakeholder Buy In:** Buy in of the necessary stakeholders and those who will be impacted by the change
3. **Open/Ongoing Communication:** Open and ongoing bidirectional communication (leaders must communicate with their teams, and teams must reciprocate)

• *When these three elements are present, the risk of failure will be heavily mitigated and the likelihood of success will be exponentially higher*
